## Flood Advice

Monday 17 October 2022

### Flood impact

The projections for the impact of flooding, this week, in Echuca and surrounds are bleak.

Whilst the level of the Campaspe River is steady at the moment, the difficult moment is in about two days' time when the Murray River's level rises and, consequently, pushes up the Campaspe.

### Services in Echuca

The following services there are not operating on Tuesday, 18 October:

- Day Services
- HUB on High
- Flexible support
- SLES
- Transport runs

Residential services and Work Crew are still operating.

The sites which are closed are High Street North (head office), High Street South and Percy Street.

Notwithstanding the scaling back of services, Vivid is still providing support to people, in Echuca and surrounds, who are in need of support.

For the reasons alluded to at the beginning of this advice, at the moment it appears very unlikely that services will resume, and sites reopen, on Wednesday 19 October.
