Vivid provides a range of care, support and pathways for over 250 adults with disability. Support plans are flexible and suit individual needs. Our staff will work with you to help you achieve your goals and, in some cases, we can provide transport for people living in rural or remote areas.

Vivid Living offers you a boutique range of living options and flexible support activities designed to empower you to live life your own way.



VIVID EMPLOYMENT

Vivid Employment provides structured employment pathways that support the achievement of your individual employment goals.



VIVID LEARNING

Vivid Learning delivers group-based programs in inclusive environments that foster connection, learning, and wellbeing.



VIVID SUPPORT COORDINATION

Vivid's Support Coordination team assists you to maximise your opportunities, access the supports of their choice, and engage meaningfully in their communities.

Vivid Living offers:

A boutique range of residential and in home supports, community access options and flexible support activities to live life your way.

SUPPORTED ACCOMMODATION

Vivid's boutique housing offers a variety of purpose-built Specialist Disability Accommodation (SDA) properties and accommodation options designed to support you to live independently and empower you to live with freedom and dignity.

Vivid also offers 'Tiny House' a welcoming space designed to boost your confidence and help you learn practical skills for everyday living through overnight stays and respite options.



SUPPORTED INDEPENDENT LIVING

Vivid has a team of dedicated staff who are committed to empowering you to live as independently as possible within your home and the community.

Support models are tailored to your needs and can include 24/7 support, overnight supports or supports as you need.



ACCESS ALL AREAS

Vivid's Access All Areas (AAA) activities are a lot of fun. Come along and enjoy a night of pizza and pool, a weekend outing in our local area or maybe travel further taking a trip to the Royal Melbourne Show or AFL.

AAA and Break Buddies can be included in your NDIS plan and activity fees are charged separately.

With the overall aim of enhancing independence, confidence, self-esteem and life choices, Vivid is committed to providing support that suits the needs of each individual we work with. This means that support can be delivered at any Vivid site, within the community, at home or in a group.

SUPPORTED EMPLOYMENT

Vivid Work Crew is an Australian Disability Enterprise that offers paid, meaningful employment in a supported environment. Vivid has three 'Crews' – Echuca, Swan Hill and Kerang. Each site and crew is unique, partnering with local businesses to get the job done!

Vivid Work Crew is made up of a team of Supported Employees and Support Workers. With the overall goal of building capacity, learning new skills and challenging yourself. Vivid Work Crew is a vibrant and fun employment setting.



SCHOOL LEAVER EMPLOYMENT SUPPORTS (SLES)

SLES offers school leavers an individualised support for up to two years to help get you ready for work and plan your pathway to employment. Your SLES plan will be tailored to meet your individual employment goals.

SLES will help to build your skills and confidence; learn about money, travel and time management and connect you with a supportive team.



SUPPORTS IN EMPLOYMENT

The path between supported employment and open employment can often feel like a big leap! Vivid Employment are excited about their partnerships with businesses that make this transition as smooth as possible.

Supports in Employment provides flexible and tailored on the job support to people with a disability who are employed directly by a local business.

Group based activities delivered in an inclusive environment that fosters connection, learning, and well-being.

GROUP BASED PROGRAMS

Vivid Learning's Group Based Programs foster connection and learning in an inclusive environment. Our program choices are designed to help you achieve your NDIS goals while providing positive experiences in a group setting. We will work with you to maximise your potential and provide opportunities based on your individual needs.

Programs are structured around key themes:

- Life Skills
- Healthy Living
- Adventure & Recreation
- Culture and Arts
- Communication & Technology
- Work Experience

Vivid has a range of specific programs that fit into these key themes and individual timetables are created based on your choices.

Programs run between 9.30am to 3.30pm Monday to Friday in Echuca and Kyabram. Contact Vivid to find out more about the program choices available to you.

Vivid's Break Buddies program offered over the Christmas and New Year break allows you to access your community in organised activities and outings. You get to hang out with your friends, visit local attractions and have a load of fun at the same time!

If you require access to our transport services, then we can arrange that as part of your support plan.



LIFE SKILLS

Build your every day living skills through accessing the community using public transport, attend social events, enjoy cooking with fresh produce and money management.



WORK SKILLS

Build upon home maintenance and work skills with activities including gardening, home tools & appliance handling, vehicle maintenance, wood work and cleaning.



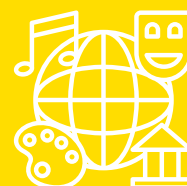
COMMUNICATION & TECHNOLOGY

THE HUB PROGRAMS



HUB SEED TO PLATE

Seed to Plate is Vivid's original HUB program. Participants learn all about growing fresh produce in our very own garden.

Caring and tending to the garden is a significant component of the Seed to Plate program and is the base for cooking and sharing delicious and healthy meals together.



HUB BLOOM

HUB Bloom centers on the cycle of growing and harvesting flowers and herbs. Learn flower arranging skills and get creative in producing garden art.

Garden art products are made from recycled and re purposed goods, making a unique and special gift by the HUB Bloom team.

Fresh garlands along with other floral products are also created and available for sale. Join the team and enjoy your colourful and creative side learning about nature and the outdoors.



HUB SHED

Be supported to undertake general maintenance, similar to a Men's Shed, where you will develop basic skills and understanding in the safe use of tools.

HUB Shed repurpose and create a range of handy works, such as bird houses and planter boxes.



CREATIVE KITCHENS

Get busy in the kitchen and learn how to:

- plan meals on a budget
- prepare and present recipes using seasonal produce
- exercise safe food handling techniques
- manage safe kitchen hygiene
- follow the steps on packaged items
- measure ingredient quantities
- share your meal with your class mates



TRANSPORT

Vivid has its very own transport network to ensure that the people we support who live in rural and remote areas can still access the services they need to thrive.

Our bus drivers head out each morning to transit people from their home to the services that they're accessing during the day. Throughout the day, our bus fleet is in use for various programs and out and about activities.

Support Coordination can assist you by:

- Exploring options and identifying the services that will meet your needs outlined in your NDIS Plan
- Overseeing and coordinating services, providers and support
- Communicating with Government, NDIA and agencies on your behalf
- Coordinating the type and timing of supports, including Service Agreements
- Directing you to the correct providers in relation to a query or concern
- Enabling information sharing between service providers
- Obtaining quotes for services
- Linking you with your local community
- Working with you to develop skills, capacity and resilience
- Linking you with new service providers and your local community
